**Ido:** I think we're in a healthy position with a really strong bogrim body at the moment. I'm enthusiastic to help make it even stronger.

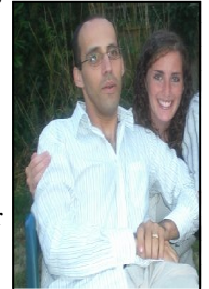
**MK?:** What do you hope to achieve in your time here with HDUK?
